

**VILLAGE OF NORTH BRANCH
AMENDMENT TO CURFEW ORDINANCE
ORDINANCE NO. 19.1**

An ordinance amending the Village of North Branch Curfew Ordinance to regulate the hours during which minors under the age of 18 years may be in or on the public streets, alleys or parks; and to provide penalties for violations thereof.

THE VILLAGE OF NORTH BRANCH ORDAINS:

The Village of North Branch Curfew Ordinance is hereby amended in its entirety as follows:

Section 1. No minor under the age of fourteen years shall be in or on any public street, alley or park between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. unless the minor is accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, or some person at least 21 years of age who is designated by the parent or legal guardian to accompany the minor.

Section 2. No minor under the age of eighteen years shall be in or upon any public street, alley or park between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. unless the minor is accompanied by parent or legal guardian, or some person at least 21 years of age who is designated by the parent or legal guardian to accompany the minor.

Section 3. No adult shall assist, aid, abet or encourage any minor to violate the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4. Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars and/or imprisonment not to exceed twenty (20) days in jail and/or community service of up to a maximum 40 hours.

Section 5. All prior ordinances, resolutions or motions adopted by the Village Council setting curfews other than the times specified in this ordinance are hereby repealed.

The undersigned President and clerk of the Village of North Branch hereby certify that this ordinance was duly adopted by the North Branch Village Council at a meeting held

on the 11th day of July, 1996 and was published in the Lapeer County Press on the 17th day

of July, 1996. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after said date of adoption.
