

**VILLAGE OF NORTH BRANCH
PERMANENT TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDER NO. 4
(Pursuant to Ordinance No. 28**

Lincoln Street

1. The following parking regulations shall be enforced, in addition to those regulations previously adopted by Traffic Control Order No. 3:

A. There will be no parking that blocks driveways or alleys.

B. There will be no parking within 20 feet of an intersection.

C. There will be no parking on the west side of Lincoln Street extending south from Huron and Banker Streets between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., except by special permits issued by the police department.

D. The police department and the department of public works shall have the authority to direct that any persons holding special permits must remove their vehicles in the event that it is necessary for snow removal or other maintenance.

2. Penalties for the violation of any of the provisions of this Traffic Control Order shall be those contained in the Uniform Traffic Code.

3. All former traffic control orders or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this order are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

4. This order shall go into effect at 12:01 a.m. on the 5th day of June, 2003.
