

**VILLAGE OF NORTH BRANCH
DESTRUCTION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY
ORDINANCE NO. 6.1**

An Ordinance making it unlawful to willfully damage or destroy public property and equipment of public utilities lawfully located on public property and to provide penalties therefore.

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to willfully damage or destroy in the Village of North Branch any public property, real or personal, including equipment of public utilities lawfully located on public property in the Village of North Branch.

Section 2. If any person, firm or corporation shall violate or fail to comply with any of the terms of these regulations, he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment in the County Jail not to exceed ninety (90) days or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective on September 19, 1974.

Section 4. All Ordinances, resolutions or order, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
